Lastly, I'd like to raise a topic published in our prior newsletter, the work on Lakeland Dr. As many of you know, the City of Dallas has initiated a drainage project that will take 2 phases to complete. Phase 1 is already in motion with a short 3-4 month duration. Phase 2 will be longer in nature, taking 6-7 months(Jan '18-July '18) as it's a larger effort. Unfortunately, this will have an impact on the traffic in the neighborhood for a bit as this project is executed and certainly end up routing traffic onto St Francis for a period of time. ## Forest Hills Security Program

The Forest Hills Security Program (FHSP) Dear Forest Hills Community, Are you "In"? No doubt you've seen the signs around the neighborhood. Some of you may be curious while others have jumped right in and joined our security program. We have had a great response, increasing participation from 33% to 54% in the last 2 months. We need to get to 100%! Why? We need more patrolled hours. A significant concern is the closing of Lakeland Road and the increase in traffic coming through our neighborhood. It is crucial for



everyone to participate to cover the cost of patrol cars, hourly pay for the officers, and new security signage going up. We currently have 34 (from 28) hours of security per week and we want to increase it to 40 plus for the holidays and beyond.

Benefits of joining the Forest Hills Security Program and having more patrol in the neighborhood:

- -Quicker response time to a 911 call
- -Safer streets
- -Monitoring of suspicious persons and vehicles
- -Protection of your home, vehicles, and valuables from theft and vandalism
- -Home Watch program
- -Increases your property value with lower crime rates
- -Positions our neighborhood as proactive against crime, reducing vulnerability
- -Tax deductible contributions
- -Police presence

Many of you have used Next Door to alert neighbors of suspicious activity. Please know that this is not a secure app. Anyone from anywhere can read it. You must call 911 even if you aren't sure if your concern is worth reporting. Officers will not be put out by calls about anything that seems "off". There are several instances where a call was put in about someone lurking about and the culprit was someone the police have been looking for. We are a big help in catching criminals. You've heard the saying "See Something Say Something." Please do so! The current wait time in Dallas is a whopping 6 hours for a non-emergency 911 call, but with increased neighborhood patrol, the Forest Hills response time is 5 minutes!

Thank you to those who have stepped up and joined the security program. We need everyone on board!

Elizabeth Carol Siar Stearns, aged 73, left this life peacefully on October 2, 2017 while watching a football game with family. Beth spent her early childhood in Westport, Connecticut, and her family later settled in Dallas, TX in 1954. Beth attended Our Lady of Good Council Academy, now Bishop Dunne. There, Beth maintained excellent grades, played as a starter her freshman year on the varsity volleyball team, competed on the speech and debate teams, and was crowned Homecoming Queen. While at Bishop Dunne, Beth met her Jesuit High School sweetheart and future husband, Parks H. Stearns, Jr. After graduating from The University of Texas with an Education degree and marrying Parks in 1967, Beth taught at Metz Elementary in Austin, TX while Parks attended UT Law School. Upon graduation Parks joined the FBI, and they relocated to Seattle, WA briefly





before settling in San Francisco, CA. Beth earned her master's degree in Early Childhood Education from

San Francisco State University and became a mother with the birth of Elizabeth Anne Stearns & Parks Harding Michael Stearns, III. The family resettled in Dallas, TX in 1980, and there Beth reengaged her teaching career at Truett Elementary, making her students the luckiest learners in the world. After retirement, Beth and Parks relaunched their antique dealership where they enjoyed discovering unique items and vintage curiosities together. An ardent fan of the Texas Rangers, Cowboys, & Longhorns, Beth knew enough and cared deeply enough to call the plays even before the officials could decide what happened. Beth is survived by Parks, her husband of 50 years, her son Michael and daughters Elizabeth and Allison; and numerous relatives. Always generous in spirit, Beth bequeathed her earthly remains to UT Southwestern Medical School to further the education of tomorrow's healers.
