



THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Hello,

With Fall approaching and Summer winding down, I imagine you've likely returned from your vacations or other summertime activities to find some random signs around the neighborhood noting, Are you In? If you happen to walk the neighborhood, you will have probably taken the time to determine this is part of the FH Security Program's effort to get residents to explore if they've paid their dues and hence to prompt such activity. With that said, I will ask the same, Are you In?, but in a different context.

Are you In-vested? Have you been contributing to the security program and remained vigilant of activities around you to make sure our neighborhood remains safe and that the incidents that have been posted on Next Door recently and that happened earlier in the summer to kids being robbed of their cell phones as our funding for summer-time patrols was getting slim. Doesn't it seem worthwhile to contribute a nominal \$20/mo or \$240/year to keep the neighborhood safe and your key investment being family and home patrolled by Dallas Police on a more regularly scheduled basis. Thanks to all of you, who jumped IN! The Forest Hills Security Program (FHSP) campaign!

Your contributions added more patrols.

To those who didn't, we still need you IN! to reach the goal of 40 patrol hours a week, which security experts recommend as optimum for Forest Hills. We are not quite there yet. With more officers leaving the Dallas police force, achieving this goal will be even more important now.

We need you INVESTED as an annual FHSP participant.

IN! Benefits: You receive the extra benefit of police watching your home while you are away. Your home value enhances in a community with a security program. Police cars are on our streets, brought here by the program. It's a small cost for a big benefit to every resident of Forest Hills to feel safe and secure in their home and on our neighborhood streets. Your FH Security Program, a peace of mind INSURANCE is priceless.

We need you INVOLVED as a community member for a safer neighborhood. Since FHSP began in 2003, crime decreased 65%. Studies prove more police patrols, fewer crimes. It works!

We need you INTERESTED enough to engage your neighbor, so that no one has to be that "one", who experiences crime first hand. We are better together. Continue to call 911, when you see suspicious activity. See Something-Say Something. Even if you are unsure, don't hesitate to use 911. Let the police experts decide the importance and priority of your call. And there is a big chance, our FHSP police patrol will be on duty and be there in minutes.

Volunteers in Patrol

Want to take a more active role in crime prevention with the Forest Hills Security Program's Police Patrol by donating your time?

Be a V.I.P.!

"Volunteers in Patrol" is a non-confrontational neighborhood citizen patrol program, which can be another layer of visibility along with the currently

scheduled FHSP Police patrol hours we have each day.

After you receive basic training on how to recognize suspicious or illegal activity, you can patrol one-hour shifts with another V.I.P. partner in your own car marked with a V.I.P magnetic sign or bike, jog or walk the 'hood in your VIP T-shirt to report activity by calling 911 or reporting lighting/traffic signs/animal issues, etc to 311.

John Mitchell, fellow FH resident has just completed the course and will head up scheduling volunteers. Please email him at jmitchell@c3site.com, if you are already certified or if you are interested in becoming a Forest Hills VIP.

The Northeast Dallas Police Department's next VIP class will be held (Sat), September 30th at the NE Dallas Police Dept from 9am-1pm. Volunteers must be at least 21 years of age, in good health, have a valid driver's license, and have no criminal record. Ash Creek - S Fork Bridges at Lakeland

Background/History

On April 26, 2016, the Dallas City Council authorized the construction of two replacement bridges on Lakeland.

- * The contractor Iowa Bridge and Culvert, LC.
- * The construction contract \$3.6 million.
- * Construction will begin September 11, 2017.

Traffic/Community Impact

- Neighborhood, commuter & Alex Sanger School traffic will be impacted by the closure.
- The Lakeland closure takes place in two parts in an effort to minimize traffic impacts.

First Closure

* Lakeland south of Westglen to Ferguson - replacement of the small bridge/culvert.

Second Closure

* 2100 Lakeland Drive just east of the Kansas City Southern Railroad to Arturo - north bridge replacement and utility improvements.

Planned Action

- South Bridge Closure
- * 1st Phase of Construction (2017) September 11 through December
- * Iowa Bridge & Culvert LC will begin work on September 11, 2017.
- * Project time line is scheduled for 300 calendar days.
- * Vehicular and pedestrian through traffic of all types are prohibited during the construction period.
- * All City of Dallas services including emergence services will continue to operate normally.

Traffic Impact/Action

- * Detour Plans all non-local traffic will be directed to Buckner Blvd.
- * Electric Message Boards placed at:
 - * Lakeland at Ferguson * Lakeland at Garland * Ferguson at St. Francis
- * Signage on St. Francis and Ferguson and at St. Francis and San Pedro Parkway reads:

No through Traffic - School Drop-off and Pick-up Only 7:00 AM - 9:00 AM 2:00 PM - 4:00 PM

English charm was the first thing that came to mind when I spotted this home for Julys yard of the month. Beautiful plantings encircle the yard providing a soft buffer from the street. Brick pillars and an iron gate (I suspect is original to the home) punctuate the entrance. Open the gate and you are transported into an English garden where lush plantings offer something blooming spring and summer!

Looking at Augusts yard of the month you somehow feel cooler even in one of the hottest months of the year here in Dallas. Contemporary, modern, elegant, "cool" describe this home - and its landscape. A tejas black gravel drive and parking area create a soft approach to the home. Step off the gravel drive and onto a concrete pad walkway flanked by cut stone pedestals topped with potted yuccas. The landscape design utilizes potted containers and Texas native plants that compliments the architectural style of this home perfectly!

Good Samaritan Episcopal Church

Good Samaritan Episcopal Church was organized in the Forest Hills neighborhood in September 1965. The first worship service was held in a private home of a Forest Hills family, and ground was broken in August 1967 for the present church located at 1522 Highland Road. Good Samaritan exists as a special house of worship in Forest Hills, offering a local and inclusive option for the practice of faith and service to the community. Good Samaritan is partnered with Sanger Elementary (and Middle School) throughout the school year, collecting and providing backpacks and school supplies for students in the fall, "Adopt a Family" at Christmas time, through weekly deliveries

of donated perishable fruits, vegetables and proteins for students in need, and through quarterly collections of non-perishable foods for same. Good Samaritan is partnered with the Forest Hills Neighborhood Association, and will again host the annual Forest Hills Yard Sale on the church campus October 7th. Service is held at 10:30 am on Sundays, and includes children's church and quarterly adult bible study. Come by on Sunday morning – all are welcome.





Join the artists in their studios for the 25th Anniversary year! FREE, SELF-PACED ART TOUR


