

Last year we had the first Forest Hills Garage Sale in many years. We had many donations to sell and an outpouring of help to set up the day before the sale as well as working the day of the sale. Many thanks to those volunteers. The profit to the Forest Hills Neighborhood Association was more than \$4,000. It was put together sort of quickly without a great deal of pre planning. We did learn some things last year that could make it even better. The main thing is to start early and make it a team effort. We need several committees of Volunteers. Here are the committees we would need: **PROMOTIONS:** Ads in White Rock Weekly, The Advocate, Flyers in local businesses, Notices at Sanger, Signs. Facebook, etc. **COLLECTIONS:** This group with pickup trucks, vans, or trailers would gather items for sale and put them in the warehouse until the sale and transport them to the sale location the evening before the sale.


