



Alex Sanger Food Pantry Items

This is by no means a comprehensive list but provides examples to those wanting to donate to the pantry. The rule of thumb is the food donated should not require multiple steps for preparation. One to two at most and foods that a younger child can open without difficulty as at times kids are home while their parents are working.

Recommendation is to buy in bulk at places like Sams, Costco, Winco etc. which assists in school distribution.

- Ready to eat canned soup
- Canned beans
- Canned soup
- Rice
- Pastas
- Ready to eat pasta dishes with easy heating requirements
- Ready to eat Mac n cheese
- Sauces
- Nut butters
- Cracker packs
- Any drinks which do not require refrigeration before opening such as healthy juice boxes, milk boxes, protein drinks, water, etc.
- Healthy snack food packs (veggie sticks, pirates booty, popcorn, trail mix, nuts, etc.
- Fruit/apple sauce pouches or easy open tops for fruit
- Cereal or trail bars
- Meals that can be prepared with minimal steps and either with microwave, or minimal stove time, or no heating required

Hygiene Closet Items

- Deodorant (for both genders) *
- Soap (for both genders)
- Toothbrushes *
- Toothpastes (preferably small ones but big tubes are fine too)
- Floss
- Tampons (assorted sizes are great)
- Maxi pads and liners (assorted sizes are good as well as nighttime ones)
- Combs or brushes
- Small bags for carrying feminine products (something like a small makeup bag or pencil pouch for example)
- Facial cleanser
- Face wipes
- Girls and boys' underwear and socks for ages Pre-K up to 6
